  - (B) Create a painting based on the theme "Love for Hong Kong".




Plate (1) Chou Lu Gun (周綠雲). *Midsummer (仲夏*). 1983. Ink and colour on paper, 165 x 86 cm.




Plate (2) Piet Mondrian. *Broadway Boogie Woogie*. 1942-1943. Oil on canvas, 127 x 127 cm.




Plate (3) M. C. Escher. *Concave and Convex*. 1955. Lithograph, 28 x 33.5 cm.






Plate (7) Edouard Manet. *Olympia*. 1863. Oil on canvas, 130.5 x 100 cm.




Plate (8) Larry River. *I Like Olympia in Black Face*. 1970. Mixed media, construction, 104 x 198 x 86 cm.




Plate (9) Wu Guan Zhong (吳冠中). A Journey to Hong Kong (香港紀行). 1998. Color and ink on paper, unknown size


