- 1. In what ways do you think your children's schooling will need to be different from your own?
- 2. Individual volunteers can contribute to the resolution of global problems. Comment on this statement, referring to one **or** two global issues you have studied.
- **3.** Clearly, bilingualism is helpful in facilitating communication. What are some other advantages of bilingualism?
- 4. Is there a need today for local or regional newspapers and/or radio stations? Discuss.
- 5. Changes in technology have led to changes in society. Discuss selected examples.
- 6. In many works of literature a character searches for something or someone. Compare the theme of the quest in two **or** three works of literature you have studied.
