- 1. You are going to speak in a school debate on the motion 'Teamwork is essential in all aspects of school life'. Decide whether you are for or against the subject, and write the text of your speech.
- 2. Compare two works you are familiar with in terms of their settings, and discuss how these relate to the text as a whole.
- **3.** A new hotel is being built in your area, as part of a larger development project. This hotel will be located next to a bird sanctuary. Permission has been granted by the City Council. You are generally in favour of the project, but have a number of concerns about potential problems. Write a letter to the head of the City Council stating your views.
- **4.** The concept of 'political correctness' is found in all aspects of life. Authors have even rewritten traditional stories to remove elements that offend readers because they indicate a sexist, racist, or religious bias. Choose all, or part of, a story that you know well, and rewrite it in a politically correct version. You do not need to refer to the original text in any way.
