Option 1 – The Fatimids AH297–567 / AD909–1171

- 1. Evaluate the role of the Ismaili ideology in the establishment of the Fatimid state.
- 2. "Al-Aziz billah was the true founder of the Fatimid Empire in Egypt." To what extent do you agree with this judgment?

Option 2 – The Ottomans AH680–1342 / AD1400–1566

- **3.** Evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of the Ottoman administration system during the reigns of Selim I (1512-1520) and Sulayman the Magnificent (1521-1566).
- 4. Explain why the Ottomans were able to rise above other Turkic groups and secure a large empire.

Option 3 – Warfare in the medieval Islamic world

- 5. Evaluate the importance of jihad in the Muslim conquests until 711 AD.
- **6.** Assess the significance of the battle of al-Qadisiyya.

Option 4 – Muslim rule in Spain AH92–897 / AD711–1492

- 7. Why was the conquest of Spain in 711 AD so easy for the Muslims?
- 8. "The ornament of the world." Assess this famous description of Islamic Cordoba.

Option 5 – The intellectual contribution of Islam

- 9. Discuss the medieval Islamic achievements in the field of medicine.
- 10. What was the contribution of Muslim intellectuals to medieval Arabic scientific thought?

Option 6 – The Islamic city, and Islamic art and architecture

- **11.** Explore the role of inscriptions in Islamic art and architecture.
- **12.** What is the finest Islamic building in the world? Give reasons for your choice.
