Topic 2: The life of the Prophet Muhammad

- **3.** Evaluate modern interpretations of the emergence of Islam.
- **4.** Discuss the effects of Muhammad's early life on his role as a statesman in Medina.

Topic 3: The period of the Rightly Guided Caliphs

- 5. To what extent is the claim that Umar was the greatest of the first four caliphs, justified?
- **6.** Discuss the changing role of the Umma during the period of the first four caliphs.

Topic 4: The Caliphate and the Imamate

- 7. To what extent did both Uthman and Ali succeed in meeting the needs of the Umma?
- **8.** Explain the significance of breakaway groups in the formation and development of the caliphate.

Topic 5: Islamic Dynasties AH41-247 / AD661-861

- **9.** "Muawiyah was the most able of all the Umayyad caliphs." To what extent can this judgment be justified?
- 10. Compare and contrast the social and economic policies of the Umayyad and Abbasid.

Topic 6: The Crusades: the threat from the West AH489-690 / AD1096-1291

- 11. Examine the events that led to the First Crusade.
- **12.** Evaluate the achievements of Baybars.

Topic 7: The Mongols: AH596-807 / AD1200-1405

- 13. Discuss the significance of Timur-i-Lang (Tamerlane) as both a political and military leader.
- 14. Why were the campaigns of the Mongols, before 1260, so successful within the Islamic world?
