Topic 2: The life of the Prophet Muhammad

- 3. Assess the importance of the Hijra on the life of the Prophet Muhammad.
- **4.** Discuss the organization and development of the new Islamic community in Medina.

Topic 3: The period of the Rightly Guided Caliphs

- 5. Discuss the internal political problems that Abu Bakr faced during his period as caliph.
- **6.** Discuss the ways in which each of the first four caliphs responded to the Byzantine and Sassanian Empires.

Topic 4: The Caliphate and the Imamate

- 7. "A time of toleration." To what extent is this a positive characteristic of the rule of Uthman?
- **8.** Explain the rise, beliefs and significance of **either** the "Twelvers" **or** the "Druzes".

Topic 5: Islamic Dynasties AH41-247 / AD661-861

- **9.** Compare and contrast the legacy of **two** of the following: Muawiya, Abd al-Malik, al-Mansur, Harun al-Rashid.
- **10.** Assess the reasons for the fall of the Umayyads.

Topic 6: The Crusades: the threat from the West AH489-690 / AD1096-1291

- 11. Discuss the establishment and nature of the Crusader States in the Islamic world.
- **12.** Evaluate the achievements of Nur-al Din.

Topic 7: The Mongols: AH596-807 / AD1200-1405

- **13.** "The Mongol invasions into the Islamic world were a disaster for Islam." To what extent do you agree with this judgment?
- 14. Evaluate the military tactics of the Mongols in their encounters with Islamic cities.
