Option 1 – The Fatimids AH297–567 / AD909–1171

- 1. What were the factors that contributed to the rise of the Fatimids in North Africa?
- 2. "The long reign of the Caliph al-Mustansir billah witnessed momentous events in the Fatimid state." Discuss.

Option 2 – The Ottomans AH680–1342 / AD1400–1566

- 3. To what extent does Sulayman (AH927–961 / AD1521–1566) deserve the title "the Magnificent"?
- **4.** "The sole purpose of the early Ottoman government was to wage war and to raise taxes to fund such wars." How far is this judgment valid?

Option 3 – Warfare in the medieval Islamic world

- **5.** Analyse the military victories achieved by the early Muslims in the conquests of the seventh century.
- **6.** Why did the Muslims triumph in war over the Crusaders (Franks)?

Option 4 – Muslim rule in Spain AH92–897 / AD711–1492

- 7. Discuss the tensions within Muslim Spain between a centralised state and minor principalities.
- **8.** Evaluate the importance of the architectural heritage of Muslim Spain.

Option 5 – The intellectual contribution of Islam

- **9.** Assess the role of the Arabs in the transmission to Europe of knowledge drawn from pre-Islamic traditions
- **10.** Assess the contribution of Ibn Rushd (Averoes) to medieval Muslim thought.

Option 6 – The Islamic city, and Islamic art and architecture

- 11. Why are Islamic buildings decorated with writing?
- 12. Evaluate the significance of the Taj Mahal as a symbol of Mogul rule in India.
