Answer **one** question. Refer closely to the works of **at least two** poets you have studied.

- 1. Poetry is often the vehicle for expressing emotion. In the work of at least two poets you have studied, explore the ways in which you have seen poets writing about feelings in an artistic and effective way.
- 2. Contrasts can be used effectively by poets to sharpen their ideas and intensify the impact of a poem. Referring to the work of at least two poets you have studied, examine the way contrast has been used in poems.
- 3. Sometimes poetry includes elements, such as dreams, that are more imaginary or fantastic than real. In the work of at least two poets you have studied, examine how they have deepened or broadened their poems with elements of fantasy.
- 4. Coming to the final lines of a poem, the reader can experience many different reactions, such as inspiration, questions or a new insight. Using at least two poets you have studied, show how they have used language and structure to achieve particular effects in their conclusions.
- 5. Poetry has been described as "the art of uniting pleasure and truth." In what specific ways have at least two poets in your study managed to deliver some truths so that they are pleasurable for readers?
- 6. Irony can be used effectively by poets to give their poems more than one level of meaning. In at least two poets you have studied, examine how and to what effect they have used various kinds of irony to enrich their poems.
