- **3.** Why do some contemporary anthropologists criticize ethnographic works that do not pay enough attention to historical context?
- **4.** "Any worthwhile pursuits in anthropology seek to understand what binds humanity in its commonalities." Discuss this statement, making reference to specific theory.
- 5. Discuss the claim that society is structured more around the competing interests of groups than around common interests.
