 - globalization.
- **6.** Examine the relationship between modernity and changes in belief systems and practices.
- 7. To what extent does ideology maintain power and authority?
- **8.** Examine ways in which the environment becomes the focus of political organization.
- **9.** Discuss how **one** of the following becomes the basis of identity formation:
 - age
 - sexuality
 - class
 - · ethnicity
 - religion.
- 10. Discuss the importance of either human rights or cultural rights in the contemporary world.
