 - the study of emotions.

4. Evaluate whether symbolism may affect **either** boundaries **or** morality.
5. Examine **either** social relations **or** belief and knowledge in relation to **one** of the following:
 - sacred/profane
 - socialization/enculturation/acculturation
 - liminality
 - marginality.

6. Discuss change in relation to **either** commodification **or** hybridity.
7. Examine the role of **either** power **or** globalization in relation to **one** of the following:
 - technology
 - transnationalism
 - political discourse
 - communication in global times.

8. Compare and contrast power in relation to **either** hegemony **or** resistance in **two** societies that you have studied.
9. To what extent is society affected by **one** of the following?
 - conflict
 - consensus
 - the state
 - systems of inequality

Development

10. Examine the role of **either** materiality **or** change in relation to development.
11. Discuss belief and knowledge in relation to **one** of the following:
 - modernization
 - sustainability
 - poverty and wealth
 - development and health.

Health, illness and healing

12. To what extent is symbolism involved in **either** healing practice **or** biomedicine?
13. Evaluate the role of **either** power **or** belief and knowledge in relation to **one** of the following:
 - illness
 - suffering
 - biomedicine, medicalization and social control
 - plural medical systems.

14. Examine the role of **either** culture **or** social relations in relation to exclusion.
15. Discuss symbolism in relation to **one** of the following:
