Grade thresholds taken for Syllabus 0606 (Additional Mathematics) in the October/November 2007 examination.

The threshold (minimum mark) for B is normally set halfway between those for Grades A and C. The threshold (minimum mark) for D is normally set halfway between those for Grades C and E. Grade A* does not exist at the level of an individual component.
