# Welcome to the IBA

The expansion in the physical and Information Communications & Technology infrastructure of IBA achieved during the last four years has now enabled us to diversify our program offerings in other areas besides consolidating the existing programs. As of now, we have completely revamped MBA and terminal BBA programs in place and the initial pangs of birth have been overcome.

The response of the students and the employers to both these programs has been very satisfying for all of us at IBA. Our BS, MS and PhD programs in Computer Sciences have gained wide recognition for their quality. The rebranding of IBA as a much broader institution of learning than a Business school only, is now gradually taking hold in public minds.

The initiation of the BS Economics & Maths program last year reinforced this trend. In 2013-14 we launched two new programs BS Social Sciences & Liberal Arts and BS Accounting & Finance - an innovative program linked to professional degrees and diplomas such as Chartered Accountancy, Chartered Banking Diploma etc. The first degree course has been designed in close collaboration with professional bodies such as ICAP and IBP who have agreed to waive off some of the requirements for our BS degree holders on the basis of the courses we would be offering. I am sure parents will feel relieved that their wards will have employable skills at the end of this degree.

BS Social Sciences & Liberal Arts program is aimed at catering to the large unmet demand of the students in this area, who were aspiring to study Liberal Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences in a high quality learning environment. IBA feels pleased in responding to this demand. These changes will impose many new challenges for our faculty and staff but all of us are committed to do our best.

# Programs of Study

A summary of the programs of study is as under:

**Bachelor of Business Administration (Morning Program):**  
The BBA Morning program at the Main Campus and the City Campus is a full-time 4-year bachelor program. This program consists of 33 core courses and 12 electives, accumulating to 144 credit hours for the BBA degree. The program offers specialization in Marketing, MIS, and Finance among others.

**Bachelor of Business Administration (Entrepreneurship):**  
BBA (Entrepreneurship) is a 4-year degree program; the program developed in partnership with Babson College of Entrepreneurship in Boston, USA. The Entrepreneurship specialization develops students' abilities to formulate ideas, explore and create. It trains them to carry out in-depth analysis of inter disciplinary subjects, and enables them to get hands on experience in industry, by applying the knowledge and training to generate and sell their ideas in the real world.

**Bachelor of Science in Computer Science (Morning Program) :**

Science The BS (CS) Program is offered at the City Campus. It is a full-time 4-year program, preparing students in Computer Science. This program consists of 62 core courses credit hours and 39 for electives along with 21 for supporting science and 15 for general areas.

**Bachelor of Science (Economics & Mathematics):**  
BS (Economics and Mathematics) is a 4-year degree program with double majors in economics and mathematics. It is designed to give students a solid foundation in both economics and mathematics. The program provides a well coordinated curriculum for students interested in pursuing masters or PhD in economics and mathematics.

**Bachelor of Science (Social Sciences and Liberal Arts) Program**

The BS in Social Sciences and Liberal Arts is a 4-year degree program in the Social Sciences with major offerings in Political Science, Psychology, and Media & Communication Studies. The program is designed to develop in students the theoretical, historical, and experiential knowledge necessary to understand how we interact with our social world through local and global contexts. To accomplish these goals, the program focuses on how students can use strategies and frames of social analysis to understand and critique our increasingly interrelated economic, political, communal, cultural, and mediated lives. Courses that comprise the Liberal Arts core introduce students to a selected range of traditional academic disciplines that comprise the liberal arts and sciences. Through these courses, students will acquire comprehensive foundational skills in both

qualitative and quantitative thinking and analysis before they engage their major field of specialization.

**Bachelor of Science (Accounting & Finance ) Program**

The BS Honors(Accounting & Finance) Degree a 4 years degree program in Fall 2013.3 Developed jointly by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan ICAP and Institute of Business Administration leads to a professional qualification. An exemption of 12 Exams of Module A to D will be granted to the prospective CA students who complete their BS (Accounting & Finance) degree from IBA. The Students of BS (Accounting & Finance) after graduating from IBA Karachi, would avail the following advantages:Karachi IBA, the program provides an exclusive opportunity to the students to receive an academic degree that,

- Exemption from Module A to D
- Complete training for 3 years
- Pass Module E & F (8 courses during training)
- Become a Chartered Accountant

**Master of Business Administration (Morning Program):**

The MBA Morning Program is a full-time 2-year program conducted at the Main Campus and the City Campus of the IBA. MBA program consists of 16 core courses, 8 electives and an MBA Project.

**Master of Business Administration (Evening Program):**

The MBA Evening Program is offered only at the City Campus. The duration of this program may vary depending on the capacity of the student to complete the course load during each semester. The minimum time allowed is 2.5 years, while the maximum duration for completing the program is 7 years. The evening program consists of 14 core courses and 10 electives. A minimum of 4 electives are needed to complete a major in a specialized field (Marketing, Management Information Systems, Finance or Human Resource Management).

**18 months MBA Program (Morning):**

For those who have obtained BBA degree from HEC recognized institute can finish their Full time MBA in just 18 months (for Non-BBAs) thus resulting in saving of the tuition fees for one semester and starting job 6 months earlier. IBA BBA with the CGPA of 2.5 and two years work experience is not required to appear at the IBA entry written test for MBA. They will directly be qualified for the next round i.e. Interview, Group discussion and Essay submission.

**Executive Education:**

The Institute combines its program of formal management education with an elaborate program of management training for executives and professionals. These specialized programs are conducted by the Center for Executive Education (IBA-CEE). The IBA-CEE provides opportunities to executives working at different echelons in organizations, to enhance their careers by gaining knowledge and insight into state-of-the-art management techniques and technologies.

Executive Education Programs consist of various training courses and workshops that are organized and conducted by the distinguished IBA faculty as well as industry leaders.

Besides open enrolment programs, the Center also offers client specific training to organizations on their request, keeping in view their unique and distinct requirements. Organizations that have benefited from the Executive Education Program include private firms, small business corporations, multinationals and transnational corporations, government departments, defence, and public sector organizations.

### **Executive MBA Program**

This flagship program offers a unique opportunity for the in-services professionals to enrich their knowledge and skills without sacrificing their job commitment and earning stream. This weekend program presents a fast track route to the Masters in Business Administration from the prestigious IBA. Executive MBA program is more suitable for the professionals aiming at acquiring leadership role and moving toward the highest level of the corporate ladder especially under C-suite (CEO, CFO, COO etc.) or an entrepreneurial role. The program format, courses, methodology and contest are developed in consultation with leading experts and worthy faculty membership.

### **Master of Science (Economics):**

MS Economics program is designed to provide a solid background in theory, quantitative methods, and applications appropriate to the needs of economists involved in private and public sectors' policy planning, analysis, and forecasting. This program emphasizes on applied economics and the application of economic analysis to related disciplines. Growth in both the business consulting and financial services has generated a strong demand for economic analysts. One reason is that decision models drawn from applied microeconomic theory are particularly useful in analyzing a firm's business potential and determining the investment value of a firm. Furthermore, individuals with strong analytical skills are in a unique position to contribute to important operational decisions.

MS Economics program consists of 11 core courses and 4 electives along with a thesis. Currently, this program is being offered at the City Campus with a duration of 2 to 2.5 years.

### **Master of Science Computer Science (Evening Program) :**

The MS (CS) Program is offered at the City Campus. This is a part time program, preparing students in Computer Science. This program consists of a minimum of 24 credit hours of coursework and a minimum of 3 credit hours of research. Courses comprise a combination of compulsory and elective courses in core and supporting areas.

### **MS Leading to PhD in Mathematical Sciences**

This program is geared towards cutting edge research in modern as well as contemporary areas of pure and applied mathematics. Pakistan has a lot of intellectual talent, which we aim to streamline, and help (academically) raise individuals having successful careers of mathematics. This program targets students who have had graduate level training in mathematics, physics, engineering, and allied sciences. Their existing knowledge base of mathematics is complemented with the MS program, the successful culmination of which naturally leads to a tenure of doctoral research.

### **PhD (Computer Science):**

The Faculty of Computer Science of the IBA offers PhD programs in Artificial Intelligence and Cognitive Systems, Wireless and Mobile Communications, Social Networks, Operations Research, Information Security, Data Mining, Analysis and Computing, Multimedia & Web and Human-Computer Interaction. Students may avail a full teaching research assistantship which comprises of an attractive monthly stipend and full tuition fee waiver. The program is composed of coursework credits and dissertation credits.

### **PhD (Economics):**

PhD program in Economics provides graduate students an opportunity to make a contribution in the development and application of knowledge in Economics. This program also enables students to conduct quality research in their specialized fields. Students after successfully completing their doctoral degree from the IBA are prepared for careers in universities, business enterprises, national and foreign banks, government organizations, and multinational companies. PhD program in Economics is a full time morning program. IBA offers teaching/research fellowship to all students enrolled in the PhD program for which they are paid a monthly stipend and tuition waiver.

### **Certificate Courses (Evening Program):**

Candidates interested in attending single courses of MBA, offered in the evening, are awarded certificates upon successful completion of the course. These certificate courses are available for people with a bachelors degree or equivalent from a recognized university. Relaxation in this requirement may be allowed for candidates sponsored by their employers. These courses are useful for those who cannot join the full-length degree or diploma programs. Selection of candidates is based on an aptitude test. Students can have their status converted to that of visiting students, upon request, before the first hourly examination of the course.

### **Visiting Students Program (Evening Program):**

The Institute also admits, without any prerequisite, visiting students in single MBA courses in the evening program, provided seats are available. These students are not allowed to take regular examinations. The visiting participants are awarded a certificate without any grade for attending the course if they maintain the attendance requirement. A visiting student is not allowed to have his/her status changed to that of a regular student during the semester.
