Question A7.

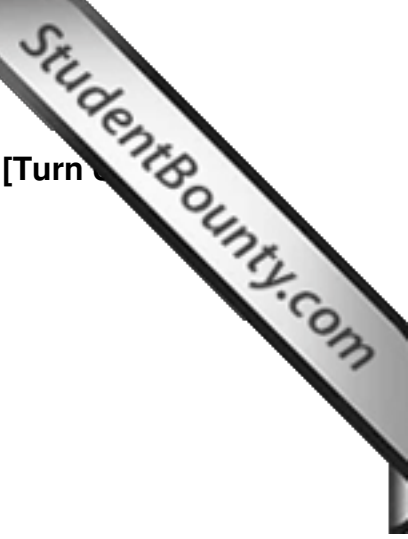
Define the term **ETHICS** and describe why **ETHICS** is so important in the Information Technology field? (5 marks)
