#### **IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR STUDENTS AND CENTRE TUTORS:**

This addendum relates to:

**Page 4, Document 2** of the **LEVEL 6 UNIT 21 PROBATE PRACTICE - CASE STUDY MATERIALS**.

In the 2<sup>nd</sup> bullet point, the 3<sup>rd</sup> sentence beginning “Under the terms of his will, when his life interest ends.....” should read “Under the terms of **her** will ...”

The sentence set out below includes the correct wording which is **emboldened and underlined**:

Under the terms of **her** will, when his life interest ends, one half of the fund is due to pass to Dorothy’s grand-daughter and the other half is to pass to a number of charitable organisations specified by Dorothy’s will.

**Page 15 Document 7** of the **LEVEL 6 UNIT 21 PROBATE PRACTICE – CASE STUDY MATERIALS**

In the 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph the date of Frederick Saunders’ death is incorrect. The date of Frederick Saunders’ death should be 3 May 2012 (and not 30 May 2012)

The paragraph set out below includes the correct date which is **emboldened and underlined**:

Yesterday I spoke to William Saunders about the estate of his brother, Frederick Saunders, who died on **3 May 2012**, aged 72. Frederick never married and had no children.
