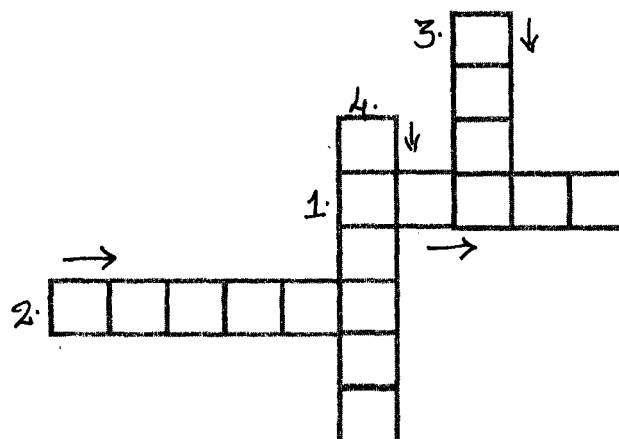

Pizza is one of America's favourite foods. No one knows how it originated, although many people claim to know. Everyone agrees, however, that it was first made in Italy. Some Italians give credit to the city of Naples, and others give Sicily the honor.

Wherever the idea started, someone probably was baking bread, decided to put little cheese and tomato sauce on top, and slipped it into the oven. Out came the world's first pizza.

Although pizza was thought of as poor man's food in Italy, it was a king who first made pizza a popular food for everyone. King Ferdinand of Bourbon in the seventeenth century, impressed by a certain cook's pizza, made him the royal *chef* and ordered him to make pizza often. The chef later wrote a cookbook in which he told how to make pizza, the King's delight.
