Distracters	B. One source code file included in the build was the wrong version C. The computation algorithm used the wrong input variables. D. The developer misinterpreted the computational requirement for that algorithm.
Justification for Correct Answer	A is clearly a failure that can be observed during testing. B From the perspective of the configuration adding a wrong version is a fault, most probably based on a mistake by the developer / CM manager C Fault D Mistake
