Rationale**

**Aims and Objectives**

The main aim of the ITEC Level 2 Award in Apply Skin Tanning Techniques is to enable Learners to gain the necessary practical and theoretical skills in order to provide Skin Tanning Treatments

The ITEC Level 2 Award in Apply Skin Tanning Techniques is comprised of 1 mandatory unit. The total credit value required to achieve this qualification is 4

It also aims:

- to provide skills at Level 2 in the Qualifications and Credit Framework for those interested in the Beauty Therapy Industry
- to provide opportunities for staff in the Beauty Therapy Industry to gain a Level 2 qualification
- to qualify Learners at Level 2 in the Beauty Therapy Industry
- to sustain the interest of Learners wanting to work in the Beauty Therapy Industry
- to encourage knowledge and understanding of the Beauty Therapy Industry at Level 2
- to provide opportunities for Learners to focus on the development of the major Functional Skills and the wider Functional Skills in a beauty therapy context, such as communicating with clients, working with others and problem solving
- to provide opportunities for Learners to develop a range of skills, techniques, personal qualities and attitudes essential for successful performance and progression onto employment in the Beauty Therapy Industry

**Assessment**

This qualification will be internally and externally assessed using the assessment of skills as set out below. Once all the internal task assessments, assignments and underpinning knowledge have been completed, the ITEC External Examiner will verify a sample of all internal task assessments and assignments

### Grading of the Qualification

- Learners must achieve a Pass grade in all technical skills and underpinning knowledge units to achieve the ITEC Level 2 Award in Apply Skin Tanning Techniques (see assessment table above)
- Internal task assessment and assignments are graded Pass or Refer
- If a Learner is unsuccessful in any area, they will be re-assessed only in the unit(s) where they were referred. The remainder of the Learner's results will stay in the ITEC system until all aspects of each unit have been allocated a Pass grade

### Opportunities for Progression

Once Learners have achieved the ITEC Level 2 Award in Apply Skin Tanning Techniques they may progress on to other ITEC or equivalent qualifications at Level 2 and 3, for example:

- Level 2 Certificate in Facial Skincare
- Level 2 Diploma for Beauty Specialists
- Level 3 Certificate in Airbrush Make-up
- Level 3 Certificate in Camouflage Make-up
- Level 3 Diploma in Advanced Beauty Therapy
- Level 3 Diploma in Fashion and Specialised Make-up
