Ἡρακλῆς ἦν Διὸς καὶ Ἀλκμήνης υἱός, καὶ ἐν σπαργάνοις ἔτι ὧν οὕτως ἰσχυρὸς ἦν ὥστε ὄφεις ἄγγειν δύνασθαι οὓς ἔπεμψεν Ἡρα ὡς διαφθεροῦντας αὐτόν. φιλόανθρωπος δ' ὧν, πολλὰ καὶ ἀγαθὰ ἔργα ἔδρασεν ἵνα οἱ ἄνθρωποι βίον ἔχοιεν εὐδαιμονέστερον. ἐν δὲ τῇ Ἡρακλέους αἴρεσει Ξενοφῶν λέγει ὅτι νεανία ὄντι τῷ Ἡρακλεῖ δύο γυναῖκες ἠπάντησαν, ὧν ἡ μὲν ἡδονὴν ἡ δὲ ἀρετὴν προὔθηκεν. ἀρετὴν δ' ἀνθ' ἡδονῆς ἐλομένω φύλαξ ἐγένετο Ἀθηναῖα. ἀλλ' Ἡρα, ἀεὶ δυσμενῆς οὔσα, δώδεκα ἄθλους ὑπομένειν ἠνάγκασεν.

A. Translate into English: (40)

Περσεὺς υἱὸς ἦν Διὸς καὶ Δανάης. μετὰ δὲ ἄλλους πόνους πορευόμενος πρὸς Αἰθιοπίαν, ἧς ἐβασίλευσε Κηφεύς, ἤυρε τὴν τούτου θυγατέρα, Ἀνδρομέδαν, δοθεῖσαν βορὰν θαλασσίῳ κήτει. Κασσιόπεια γάρ, ἡ Κηφέως γυνή, Νήρησιν ἤρισε περὶ κάλλους, καὶ πασῶν εἶναι κρείσσων ἠύχησεν· αἱ δ' οὖν Νήρηδες βαρέως ἔφερον, καὶ Ποσειδῶν συνοργισθεὶς κήτος ἔπεμψεν ἐπὶ τὴν Αἰθιοπίαν ἀναγκασθεὶς δ' ὑπὸ τῶν πολιτῶν Κηφεύς προὔθηκεν Ἀνδρομέδαν τῷ κήτει. ταύτην θεασάμενος ὁ Περσεύς, καὶ ἔρασθεὶς, διέφθειρε τὸ κήτος, καὶ ἔλαβεν Ἀνδρομέδαν γυναῖκα.

3. Translate into English:

(Hector kills Patroclus, Achilles' comrade. With help from Athena, Achilles kills Hector.)

ἐπεὶ Πάτροκλος, Ἀχιλλέως ἑταῖρος, ἐθέλει σῶζειν τοὺς Ἕλληνας, ὁ Ἔκτωρ ἀποκτείνει αὐτόν. ὁ οὖν Ἀχιλλεὺς πρὸς τὴν μάχην τρέχει καὶ εὕρισκει τὸν Ἔκτορα. ἐπεὶ δὲ ὁ Ἔκτωρ τὸν Ἀχιλλεὺς βλέπει, φεύγει. τὸν μὲν Ἔκτορα διώκει ὁ Ἀχιλλεὺς, ἡ δὲ Ἀθήνη φαίνεται ὡς ὁ τοῦ Ἔκτορος ἀδελφὸς καὶ πείθει τὸν Ἔκτορα μάχεσθαι. εὐθὺς δὲ ὁ Ἀχιλλεὺς βάλλει τὸ δόρυ, τὸν δὲ Ἔκτορα οὐ βλάπτει. ἔπειτα δὲ ὁ Ἔκτωρ ὀρμάται πρὸς τὸν Ἀχιλλεὺς, ὁ δὲ Ἀχιλλεὺς δόρυ αὐθις βάλλει καὶ ἀποκτείνει αὐτόν.

μάχη: battle.

φαίνομαι: I appear.

ὡς: as.

δόρυ: spear.

βλάπτω: I harm.

ὀρμάομαι: I rush.

4. Read the following passage and then answer any six of the questions which follow:

(Theseus saves his comrades but abandons Ariadne.)

οὕτως οὖν ὁ Θησεὺς τοὺς ἑταίρους σῶζει καὶ ἀπὸ τῆς Κρήτης ἀποφεύγει. πρῶτον μὲν οὖν πρὸς νῆσόν τινα, Νάξον ὀνόματι, πλέουσιν. ἐπεὶ δὲ ἀφικνοῦνται, ἐκβαίνουσιν ἐκ τῆς νεῶς καὶ ἀναπαύονται.

ἐπεὶ δὲ γίνεταί ἡ νύξ, οἱ μὲν ἄλλοι καθεύδουσιν· ὁ δὲ Θησεὺς οὐ καθεύδει ἀλλὰ ἥσυχος μένει· οὐ γὰρ φιλεῖ Ἀριάδνην οὐδὲ βούλεται φέρειν αὐτὴν πρὸς τὰς Ἀθήνας. δι' ὀλίγου οὖν, ἐπεὶ καθεύδει ἡ Ἀριάδνη, ὁ Θησεὺς ἐγείρει τοὺς ἑταίρους καὶ, “σιγάτε, ὦ φίλοι,” φησὶν· “καιρὸς ἐστὶν ἀποπλεῖν. σπεύδετε οὖν πρὸς τὴν ναῦν.”

ἐπεὶ οὖν εἰς τὴν ναῦν ἀφικνοῦνται, ταχέως λύουσι τὰ πείσματα καὶ ἀποπλέουσιν· τὴν δ' Ἀριάδνην λείπουσιν ἐν τῇ νήσῳ.

Νάξος: Naxos (an island).

ἀναπαύομαι: I rest.

ἥσυχος: quiet.

ἐγείρω: I wake up (someone).

πείσματα: ropes (holding the ship).

- (b) What do they do when they arrive there?
- (c) When night comes what do the comrades do?
- (d) Why does Theseus not want to take Ariadne to Athens?
- (e) What does Theseus say to his comrades?

- (g) Give the Genitive Case, Singular Number, of two of the following nouns:
Ἀριάδνη, ἑταῖρος, νῆσος, ναῦς.
- (h) The word *philanthropist* comes from two Greek words. What are they, and what does each Greek word mean?

 - (i) She was the goddess of the hearth and sister of Zeus.
 - (ii) He was the god of war.
 - (iii) She was the goddess of love.
 - (iv) He was the god of the underworld.

Write a short paragraph about *any one* of the gods or goddesses you have named.

- (b) Imagine that you are a boy or a girl in ancient Athens. Write about a recent visit to the theatre by your family.
