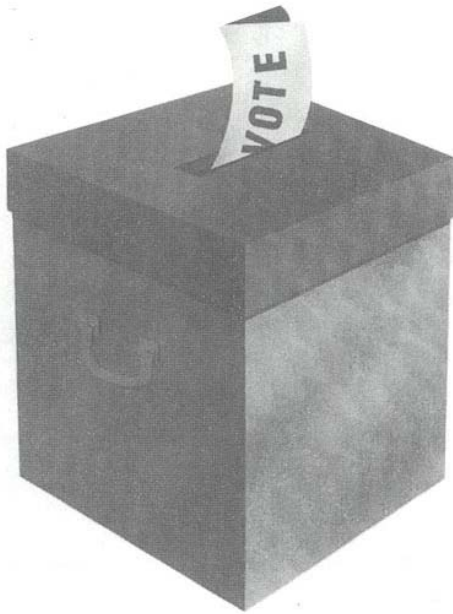

# Application for Registration

### NOTES

Next year's Register of Electors is now being compiled. Ensure that you and members of your household will be registered by completing and returning this form **IMMEDIATELY**.

#### Be Sure to Include:

- Every person over 18 living at your address;
- 17 year olds who will be 18 by 15th February next;
- Anyone who normally lives at your address but is temporarily away.

#### Do Not Include:

- A visitor staying temporarily at your address.

#### Citizenship

While every resident is entitled to be registered, the registration authority needs to know a person's citizenship to determine at which elections a person may vote. The right to vote is as follows:

**Irish citizens** may vote at every election and referendum;

**British citizens** may vote at Dáil, European and local elections;

**Other EU citizens** may vote at European and local elections;

**Non-EU citizens** may vote at local elections only.

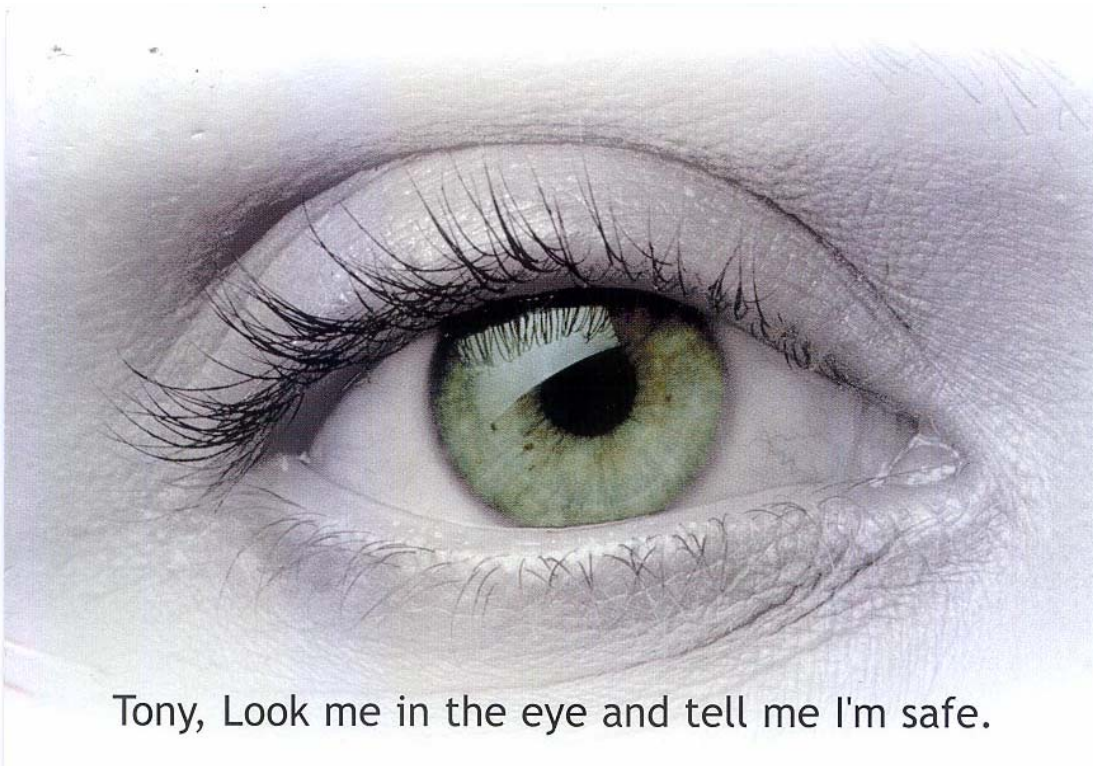
**It is an offence** to fail to give the registration authority any information required for the purposes of its duties or to give false information.

Tear this postcard off and post it on or by the 19th April 2002.

This card is your voice. It is your opportunity to help shut down Sellafield, which is a danger to your life and the life of your friends and family. The postage is paid\* All you have to do is sign it and **POST IT ON OR BY THE 19TH APRIL 2002.**

All cards will be delivered to the UK together to coincide with the anniversary of the Chernobyl Disaster.

\* The postage of this card for Tony Blair is paid, but please do more and buy the cards for Prince Charles & Norman Askew at your Post Office, or at shops or businesses participating in this campaign. All profits from the sale of these cards will go to the Chernobyl Children's Project.

**Tony,**

Look me in the eye and tell me I'm safe if there's a major incident in Sellafield.

Radiation does not respect borders. Depending on which way the wind blows large areas of my country would be made uninhabitable. Forever.

As it stands, BNFL dump millions of litres of radioactive waste into the Irish Sea everyday.

This is the sixteenth Anniversary of the Chernobyl disaster. The world can't afford another, and neither can you. Don't be blind to the danger, Tony. The risks are too great.

Please shut down Sellafield. For all of us.
