
1. <u>LIFE IN MODERN CITIES</u>

 - (ii) Suggest TWO ways crime might be reduced in cities. [4]






COST OF LAND PER UNIT AREA


B. TOURISM

Explain **THREE** reasons why tourism is important in the area you have named. [10]


C. POPULATION IN AN UNEQUAL WORLD
