 precedes it is awarded the same marks as the word or expression which
 follows it. Answers separated by a forward slash cannot therefore be taken as
 different answers.

N.B. In all sections of the examination the answers given on the marking scheme should not be considered as the only possible answers that may be accepted. Answers which are synonymous with or equivalent to those on the published marking scheme are also acceptable.

Multiple-choice questions:

- Where 2 answers are ticked and not cancelled = 0 marks.
- Where 2 answers are ticked and 1 answer is cancelled, consider non-cancelled answer.
- Where only one answer is given and is cancelled but correct, consider this as the answer.
