An excellent answer will show an ability to recognise different types of communities by accurately identifying one accurate example of a community.

1 C Suggest two reasons why people need to live in a community. 2

An excellent answer will recognise the characteristics of communities by suggesting two accurate reasons which account for the human need to live in a community.

An excellent answer will be able to recognise moments of conflict in the life of Jesus and show a familiarity with the Gospel accounts of his death by giving an accurate account of one incident that led to his death.

An excellent answer will show a familiarity with the Gospel accounts of the death of Jesus by setting out accurate information on two reasons why the incident described above led to the death of Jesus.

An excellent answer will show a familiarity with the Gospel accounts of the death of Jesus by setting out accurate information on how Jesus' death affected the people who were following him.

An excellent answer will show knowledge of the sources of information about Jesus of Nazareth and an ability to differentiate between documents of faith and documents of history by setting out accurate information on two historical sources and examining the ways in which they are similar to what the gospels say about Jesus' life and death.

Describe a time of year that is important for members in one of the above world religions. In your answer you should explain why that time of year is important for followers today.
