Communication clear and accurate / point developed / good range of vocabulary / verbs and tenses correct.

5-6 marks
Reasonably comprehensible to Spanish monoglot / point not fully developed / verbs or tenses often wrong, but some communication reasonably comprehensible / quite a limited range of vocabulary.

3-4 marks

Basic communication / part of content comprehensible / basic language content / verbs or tenses mostly wrong / some communication. 1 - 2 marks

Incomprehensible. 0 marks

## Reasonable Accommodations:

In Sections B and C of the Written Production Section, candidates who have been granted a spelling/grammar waiver should not be penalised for grammatical or spelling errors. Marks should be awarded for communication and vocabulary only.

In Sections B and C of the Written Production Section, spelling will not be taken into account where candidates who have availed of the use of a tape-recorder, a scribe or a spell-enabled computer. Marks should be awarded normally for communication, grammar and vocabulary.
