

		*Skin where tattoo is to be applied is cleaned and dried.

#### 3 points @ 4 marks each

\*Its important to ensure that the tattoo studio is clean and safe and that all equipment

used such as needles, gloves, masks etc. are disposable and everything else is sterilised.

\*Some people can have an allergic reaction to the ink used

\*The tattoo will have to be cared for until it heals

\*Even after it heals a tattoo is more susceptible to the suns rays and requires covering with a sunscreen

Discuss the removal of permanent tattoos. 2 points @ 4 marks each (8 marks)

\*Completely removing some tattoos can occasionally be difficult depending on factors

such as the size of the tattoo, types and colours of inks used, and how old the tattoo is

\*Laser methods of removal are quite successful though

\*A number of visits are required and it can be just as uncomfortable as having a tattoo applied

\*Can be very costly and sometimes costs more than having the tattoo applied in the first place

\*Run bristles under warm not hot running water

\*Apply a small amount of shampoo to the bristles and work into lather

\*Rinse under running water

\*Continue rinsing until no further colour leaves the brush and all the shampoo is removed

#### Drying

\*Shake the brush sharply to remove excess water

\*Pat gently with kitchen paper

\*Lay flat on kitchen paper to air dry
