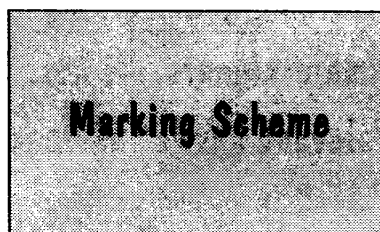

11 - 12 marks	<p>Mention a reasonable amount of the key points.</p> <p>Moderate level of proficiency in reading finger-spelling.</p> <p>Good effort made to present some detail in the answers.</p>	
9 - 10 marks	<p>Grasping some of the key points. Showing some ability to comprehend the story. Reasonable effort made to present some detail in the answers.</p>	
6 - 8 marks	<p>Fair effort made to capture some of the facts presented in the story. Fair attempt at answering made.</p>
