Penalty system applies as follows:

Major error = - 3. i.e. omission of verb, wrong construction or mood; but only one block penalty to be applied per construction.

Lesser error = - 2. i.e. wrong tense, voice, number, case, omission of noun, adjective, pronoun, *ut, ne, se*, etc.

Minor error = - 1 i.e. wrong gender, degree of adjective or adverb, misspelling or vocabulary error.
