





# Worst ever oil pollution



Brest, March 23

The grounding of the Amoco Cadiz is now the biggest pollution disaster in tanker history. Oil is still leaking fast from the stricken ship and there is little hope of pumping out any of the remaining oil.

Battered by gale-force winds, the last of the giant tanker's 14 storage tanks has ruptured and is leaking oil.


The pollution disaster has affected more than 60 miles of French coastline which includes fishing ports and holiday areas. Last night a 'breakaway' oil slick was reported about 50 miles from the Channel Islands but a forecast of northerly winds suggests that France will have the Amoco's entire cargo driven on to its shores.
