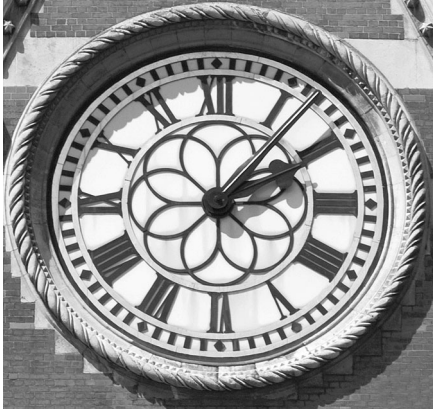

These photographs of clocks were taken in London.

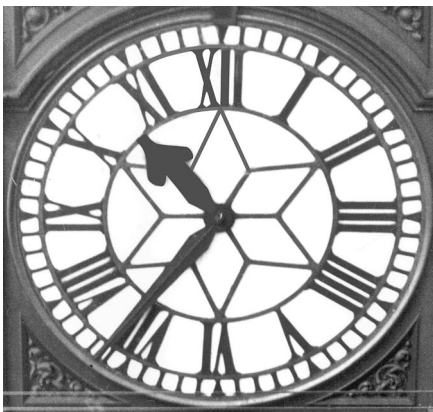
The clock faces are decorated with patterns.

King's Cross Station



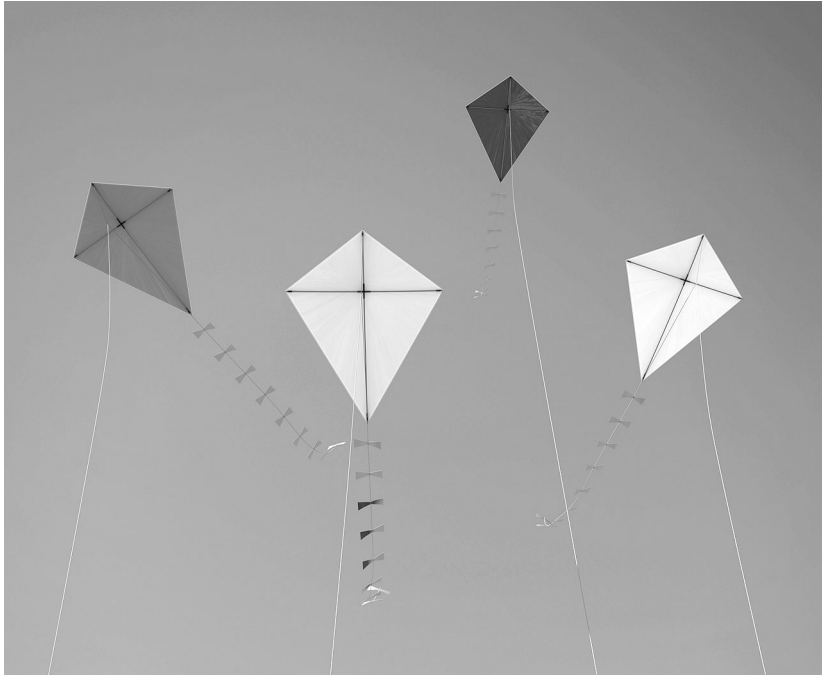
Paddington Station



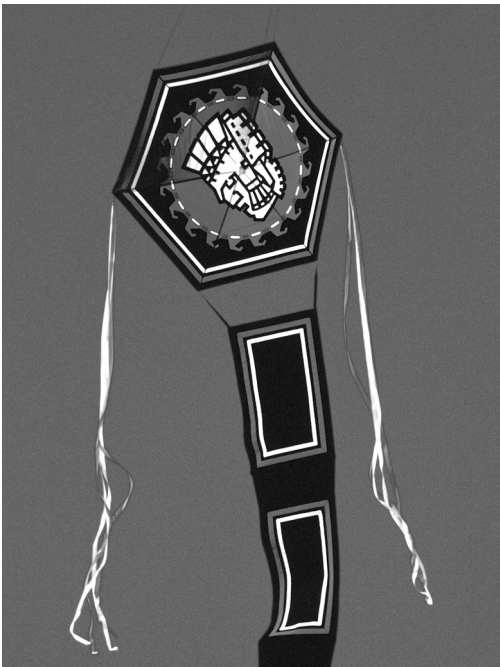
Big Ben Clock Tower
