- 2 Design a poster advertising an ice-cream outlet. You may include any additional illustration or decoration you feel appropriate. There is no limit on the number of colours to be used, but the following words **must** be included:

COOL CAT ICES  
50 FLAVOURS  
CENTRAL PARK

- 3 Design a repeat pattern for wrapping paper based upon shapes found in FRUITS and SEEDS. You are limited to black and white and two other colours.
- 4 Design the logo for a company which manufactures computer games. The name of the company is ZAP. Show in colour how your final design would appear on the company website.
- 5 Using an appropriate calligraphic script with which you are familiar, design the page of a book using all or part of the following extract:

The Night Will Never Stay

*The night will never stay,  
The night will still go by,  
Though with a million stars  
You pin it to the sky;  
Though you bind it with the blowing wind  
And buckle it with the moon,  
The night will slip away  
Like sorrow or a tune.*
