If a candidate breaks any of the apparatus, or loses any of the material supplied, the matter should be rectified and a note made in the Supervisor's Report.

It is assumed that the ordinary apparatus of a science laboratory will be available, including a supply of purified water (distilled or deionised).

If arrangements are made for different sessions for different groups of candidates, care must be taken to ensure that the different groups of candidates are effectively isolated so that **no information passes** between them.

Question 1

Each candidate will require:

- (i) a piece of celery, approximately 10 cm long (kept fresh in an enclosed container until just before the start of the examination);
- (ii) a scalpel or a sharp knife;
- (iii) a beaker, medium size, (or similar container);
- (iv) a hand lens;
- (v) access to a supply of blue or black ink or stain, in a container with a dropper;
- (vi) access to a supply of iodine solution, in a container with a dropper;
- (vii) access to a tap and sink;
- (viii) sight of a clock, with a second hand;
 - (ix) a white tile.

Question 2

Each candidate will require:

- (i) approximately 60 (±3) grains of cooking rice; (This should be a 50-50 mixture of two kinds of rice:
 - 1. short grained 'Pudding' rice;
 - 2. long grained rice.

These are to be counted out separately, then mixed for the candidates' use.)

- (ii) a small sheet, approximately A5 size, of black paper;
- (iii) a ruler (mm).
