There are no half marks.</p> <p>Place the tick for a correct box over the last word of the group Add the number of ticks and place total below the script, divide the total by 2, place the final total in the margin and circle the number</p> <p>Each box must be completely correct to be awarded a point Additional guidance is given beside some boxes.</p> <p>The first two "minor" errors (accents, hyphens, capital letters) <i>in an otherwise correct box</i> will forfeit the mark for that box. Once TWO minor errors have been dealt with in this way, further such errors should be ignored.</p> <p>Spelling out punctuation (including "à la ligne) and incorrect spelling of a proper noun written on a board for the candidates is a "minor" error.</p> <p>Consequential and identical errors (<u>underlined</u>), as well as incorrect punctuation, should be ignored.</p>
