## TURKISH 7646, MARK SCHEME

#### **QUESTION 1 – TRANSLATION FROM TURKISH INTO ENGLISH**

This part of the paper is marked out of twenty-five.

- 20 negative marks, subject to usual deductions for errors and omissions
- 1 mark off for serious error or omission
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> mark off for minor error or omission
- up to 2 marks off for a phrase or part of a sentence which distorts the meaning of the message in the sentence
- up to 4 marks for spelling
- 5 positive marks for elegance/fluidity of expression

#### **QUESTION 2 – TRANSLATION FROM ENGLISH INTO TURKISH**

This part of the paper is marked out thirty.

Marks should be distributed in the following way:

- correct decoding 7
- correct encoding 7
- Iinguistic accuracy
  8
- cohesion/fluidity
  8

#### **QUESTION 3 – SENTENCES TESTING GRAMMATICAL KNOWLEDGE**

This part of the paper is marked out of thirty.

### **TURKISH 7646, CHIEF EXAMINER'S REPORT**

Turkish O level is a small, successful and extremely popular subject which continues to attract many overseas candidates.

This year, as in previous years, the majority of the candidates were native Turkish speakers, but it is pleasing to see a growing number of non-native candidates entering for the examination. The success rate of candidates this year has been in line with previous years. As always it was very pleasing to award good grades to candidates who performed very well. The majority of candidates achieved grades above C, many gaining grades A and B.

The two passages for translation, the sentences testing grammatical knowledge and the essay topics were all accessible to most candidates. The passage for translation in Question 2, in the form of a letter, was particularly well received and handled very well by the majority of candidates.
