1	The Zoos A well-organized modern zoo, not only provides people an opportunity of close encounter with animals they do not know but also makes sure that the animals are provided enclosures similar to their natural habitat and can breed. Endangered species whose numbers are gradually decreasing or those who are about to become extinct can reproduce in zoos under conservation programmes. One of the oldest zoos known today was established about 1100 B.C. in China. In the older days, kings used to keep a large collection of animals and it is most likely that the idea of setting up zoos open to public originated from there. Botanic Gardens in Paris known for its extraordinarily broad collection of plants were also the first example of modern zoo. Amsterdam Zoo in Holland was set up in 1837 and the last kuaga, a specie from Zebra family, died there. Frankfurt Zoo is one the best in Europe and many animals close to	

	extinction have bred there successfully. Another zoo, in Stellingen, a town near to Hamburg has a special reputation. Because, Karl Hagenbeck's idea of removing cage bars and fences and separating animals from each other and from public by well-hidden burrows and ditches, was first put into practice there. Today the number of animals caught in the wild and taken to zoos is very low. Most are born in zoos and being bred and exchanged with other animals between other zoos. The number of some animals is in such a decline in the wild, it is impossible to find a male and a female for breeding.	(25)

Yasama organları emisyonu kontrol edebilmek için kurallar getiriyorlar. Okuldaki ve üniversitedeki öğretmenler öğrencilerine çok küçük yaşta hava kirliliğinin etkilerini öğretmektedirler.	
	Hava kirlliğine bir çözüm bulmanın ilk yolu değerlendirmedir. Araştırmacılar dşardaki hava kirliliğini incelemiş, hava kirliliğinin türünü ve miktarını ölçmek için yöntemler geliştirmişlerdir.
