3. A 5 year old child requires the extraction of a carious mandibular left second deciduous molar. What methods of pain and anxiety control are available and what factors would you take into consideration in deciding which to use?

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1. A 5 year old child presents with carious teeth. What preventive measures should be incorporated in the treatment plan?
2. A 12 year old child presents with tooth surface loss affecting first permanent molars and maxillary incisors. List the possible causes and discuss the treatment options.
3. Define the term infraocclusion. Discuss the clinical problems which may result from infraocclusion and the treatment options available.
