<p>(b) Candidates should be awarded a mark for any of the following points, maximum 2 marks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Oedipus saved Thebes before from the Sphinx• Oedipus solved the riddle of the Sphinx• Oedipus is their king• Any other reasonable point	2
<p>2. (a) Candidates should be awarded a mark for any of the following points, maximum 2 marks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Unclean thing/pollution lives amongst them• Murderer of Laius lives in the city• Murderer must be brought to justice• Any other reasonable point	2
<p>(b) Candidates should be awarded a mark for any of the following points, maximum 2 marks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• He decides to find killer of Laius• The killer of Laius is to be banished• Any other reasonable point	2

 - clogs
 - toilets
 - warm room, cold room, changing room etc.

- Candidates may be awarded a second point for a more detailed explanation of each point. (maximum of 4 marks)

5. (a) Candidates should be awarded a mark for any of the following points, maximum 1 mark.
- The first woman
 - Any other reasonable answer

- (b) Candidates should be awarded a mark for any of the following points, maximum 3 marks.
- She opened the box of troubles
 - She released hatred, envy, spite, old age etc
 - Men were now afflicted by these although they had not been previously
 - Any other reasonable point
- 3**
6. Candidates should be awarded one mark for the naming of any one of the following:-
- river Styx
 - waters of Lethe
 - Cerberus
 - Charon
 - Judges of the dead
 - any other accurate point
- Candidates may be awarded a second point for a more detailed explanation of each point (maximum of 4 marks)

Section B

Classical Drama – Sophocles, *Oedipus the King*

1. (a) Candidates should be awarded a mark for any of the following points, maximum 3 marks.
- Oedipus expected answers from Teiresias
 - Teiresias refuses to tell Oedipus what he knows
 - Oedipus loses his temper
 - Oedipus insults Teiresias
 - Teiresias claims Oedipus is the cause of the plague
 - Any other reasonable point
- 3**
- (b) Candidates should be awarded a mark for any of the following points, maximum 2 marks.
- Oedipus accuses Creon of plotting with Teiresias
 - Oedipus thinks Creon wants to be king
 - Creon denies this claim
 - Any other reasonable point
- 2**
2. Candidates should be awarded a mark for any of the following points, maximum 5 marks.
- Oedipus has lost
- his position as king
 - his wife
 - his sight
- Oedipus is in disgrace because
- he killed his father
 - married his mother
 - had incestuous children
 - any other reasonable point

3. Candidates should be awarded one mark for any one of the following points:-

- altar
- statues
- pillars
- steps
- description of architecture
- any other accurate point

Candidates may be awarded a second point for a more detailed explanation of each point (maximum of 4 marks)

4. (a) Candidates should be awarded one mark for any one of the following points:-

- hardcore base
- camber – curved surface
- ditches
- tended to be straight
- any other accurate point

Candidates may be awarded a second point for a more detailed explanation of each point (maximum of 3 marks)

(b) Candidates should be awarded a mark for any one of the following points:-

- allowed army to move quickly
- preserved order
- allowed fast travel of Roman officials
- allowed fast movement of goods and supplies
- any other accurate point

Candidates may be awarded a second point for a more detailed explanation of each point (maximum of 2 points)

5. Candidate should be awarded a mark for any of the following points, maximum 5 marks.

- They built a boat to survive storm
- Storm raged 9 days and nights
- Earth flooded, human race depleted
- Deucalion and Pyrrha consult gods
- Prophecy – throw bones of mother behind you
- D. & P. throw rocks over shoulders
- Rocks become men and women
- Human race repleted
- Any 5 of the above or any other reasonable point

6. Candidates should be awarded one mark for any one of the following points:

- daughter of Demeter
- abducted by Hades
- Demeter's protest
- the tale of the pomegranate seeds
- the judgement of Zeus

NB Candidates may be awarded up to two marks for an extended explanation or description of each point (maximum of 5 marks).
