### The Extraneous Rule

X e

### *Extraneous Material*

Extraneous material may be penalised, depending on whether the extra information is insufficient or wrong.

For the rule to apply, the candidate must firstly have exceeded the total items for which points are awarded and the additional information must be **wrong**. The maximum deduction per question/sub-question for extraneous material is 1 point.

To indicate such a penalty, cross one of the ticks awarded and put an e beside it: X e

### Examples (Question 9 – 2 points available)

1. Likes contact with <sup>✓</sup> people, would like to <sup>✓</sup> travel and experience <sup>(✓)</sup> new countries. = 2
2. Likes contacting <sup>×</sup> people, working around <sup>×</sup> the world and discovering <sup>X e</sup> new countries. = 0
3. Likes <sup>Irr</sup> people, discover <sup>✓</sup> new countries and having <sup>Irr</sup> new experiences. = 1
4. Enjoys <sup>×</sup> talking, gets on well with <sup>Ins</sup> people and wants to see <sup>Ins</sup> new places. = 0
5. Likes meeting <sup>X e</sup> new people, working with <sup>×</sup> young people, discovering <sup>✓</sup> new countries. = 1
