(d) What memories does she have of Morocco? Mention any two things.

- Big/grand/large house(s)
- Beautiful/pretty/lovely/nice beach(es)
- open air/outdoor/outside market(s )/shopping in the open air/street market(s)
- boat trip
- (it is) a beautiful country
(2 from 5)



## Questions/Acceptable answers

(e) She said the Moroccans were very welcoming. What other advantage does she mention?

- They/many/some spoke French/to speak French an advantage
- could understand her/each other/she could understand them /they could understand French


## Unacceptable answers

1 mark

They understand English

She could come again with her friends in summer
She made lots of friends
They were understanding

## Questions/Acceptable answers

2. While in Lille you eat in a famous restaurant which has just won an award. At the end of the meal you meet Jean, the head chef, who tells you about himself and his career.
(a) For how long has Jean been a chef?

- (For) 11 years
(b) Why did he want to be a vet when he was younger? Mention any one thing.

1 mark

- Lives/lived/worked/was brought up on a farm/his dad/they had animals/helped dad on farm
- Looked after /helped with the animals
N.B. any indication of future intention negates the point.
(1 from 2)

## Irrelevant/Insufficient

Pets
Dad worked with animals

Helped animals
Liked animals
Wanted to help animals

## Questions/Acceptable answers

(c) What happened that forced Jean to learn how to cook? Mention any one thing.

- Mum (had to spend two weeks) in hospital
- His dad visited her every day/often/regularly
- Had to cook for brother(s)/feed his brother(s)
(1 from 3)


## Unacceptable answers

## Irrelevant/Insufficient

His mum was ill

Dad went to hospital Dad was away a lot

Had to cook meals/dinner

## Questions/Acceptable answers

(d) He says that being a chef is hard. What two examples does he give of this?

- Has to wake up/get up/come in/prepare/work/start early (in the morning)
- (Often) works 15 hours a day
(e) What does he love about his job? Mention any two things. 2 marks
- (Working with) his team/he gets to work in a team/he has a great team
- Inventing/creating (new) recipes/being creative/(making) new dishes
- Customer satisfaction/when people like his food/ customers returning/customers thank him for his food/ compliment him for his food/satisfying his regular customers

(a) What disruption has been caused because of the bad weather? Mention any two things.

2 marks

- No water/electricity/power cuts/water is off
- Airports/have had to cancel flights/flights cancelled/disrupted/flights off/planes can't take off
- (lots of) schools closed/off
- Roads are dangerous/icy/slippy

Electricity/water problems $(20 \mathrm{~cm})$ snow has fallen Heating

Public transport
Bad traffic
Lots of people stuck in airport Airports closed

Children can't get to school

## The Extraneous Rule



## Extraneous Material

Extraneous material may be penalised, depending on whether the extra information is insufficient or wrong.
For the rule to apply, the candidate must firstly have exceeded the total items for which marks are awarded and the additional information must be wrong. The maximum deduction per question/sub-question for extraneous material is 1 mark.
To indicate such a penalty, cross one of the ticks awarded and put an e beside it:
