- -½ for use of plural noun instead of singular, or vice versa.
- -1/2 mark for use of wrong tense.
- $-\frac{1}{2}$ mark for not contextualising vocabulary accurately.
- -1 for not adhering to choices when multiple choice forms part of answer.
