Advantage and disadvantage must be given for two marks.
Possible answers include:
Advantages: flat/gently sloping land (1) so easy to use machinery (1) fertile soils (1) close to river for water/irrigation (1) close to main road for moving products to market (1)

Disadvantages: risk of flooding (1) growth of new housing may lead to loss of land (1) locals/visitors could walk over land trampling crops (1) vandalising land (1) noise or fumes from main road (1)

If YES chosen reasons should include:
Flat land next to river (1) easy to build on (1) close to water supply (1) easy to build roads on flat land (1) river can be bridged (1)

If NO chosen reasons should include:
Steep land to north (1) limits expansion of settlement (1) land south of river is on a flood plain (1) liable to flood (1)

Several roads meet (1) A84 meets A81 (1) minor/C class roads in squares 6207 and 6307 (1)

Possible answers for service centre:-

Mixed Farming: There is both low and high land (1) gently sloping land suitable for crops (1) sheep can cope with hilly land (1) gently sloping land is suitable for machinery (1) warmer on lower land so crops could be grown (1) hills too steep for machinery (1)

Sheep Farming: Most of the land is steep so suited to sheep (1) poor soil on hills so not suitable for crops (1) machinery is difficult to use on hills (1) flatter land is close to water so could flood (1) colder and windier on hills which suit sheep but not crops (1)
