		NB: Relax because of stress = 2 marks

9.	2	<ul> <li>Any TWO of:</li> <li>They/we (have to) visit the <u>sights/go sightseeing</u> (and that doesn't interest him)/He's not interested in (visiting) the <u>sights/sightseeing</u>.</li> </ul>	Museum etc.	
		• His parents/they don't (want to) go out/do anything at night/in the evening/enjoy the nightlife/He wants to/he's not allowed to go out at night/in the evening/enjoy the nightlife.		
		<ul> <li>They/we (have to) stay in (the hotel) in the evening/at night.</li> <li>MUST MENTION 'IN THE EVENING/AT NIGHT' IF NOT ALREADY MENTIONED IN BULLET POINT 2</li> <li>NB: He wants to go out in the evening instead of staying in the hotel = 2 marks</li> </ul>		<u>a</u> hotel Specific wrong activity – eg Have a bath
