10.	3	<p>Any THREE of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (He says) <u>granny/she</u> can cook <u>better/is a better</u> cook (than her/his mum/his parents). • He <u>knows</u> (lots of) <u>young</u> people/youths/teenagers/children/(There are) (lots of) <u>young</u> people/youths/teenagers/children <u>near/nearby/close by/not far away/round about</u>. • He won't get bored/It won't be boring. • He can (help grandad to) mow/maintain/cut the <u>lawn/grass</u>. 	<p>Food is better</p> <p>There/in the area He has <u>friends</u> nearby</p> <p>Garden(ing)</p>	<p>Grandad/he</p> <p>Specific wrong activity – eg weeding/ housework</p>
