Example of the extraneous rule

Question 3(a) – 2 marks available

They are worried about the new school year (1 mark)

They want to get better grades (1 mark)

Total = 2 marks

They are worried about the new school year (1 mark)

They want to get better grades (1 mark)

They get bored (a correct answer, but 0 marks, as the full 2 marks available have already been awarded)

Total = 2 marks

They are worried about the new school year (1 mark)

It's boring (0 marks, as it's insufficient)

Total = 1 mark

They are worried about the new school year (1 mark)

They want to get better grades (1 mark)

It's boring (0 marks, as it's insufficient, but no marks deducted, as although this is extra information and in itself would not attract a mark, it is in the middle column rather than the unacceptable column and is therefore just to be ignored)

Total = 2 marks

They are worried about the new school year (1 mark)

They want to get better notes (wrong - in unacceptable column)

They get bored (1 mark)

Put a tick beside each of the 2 correct answers, then cross out one of the ticks and write E beside it. The candidate has a mark deducted because he/she has given **extra information which is wrong**.

Total = 1 mark
