- Treats it like a human: And now it goes by the shadowed way


## Possible no reasons:

- Exaggerated tone, she may think he is mocking her:

O goddesses and gods of love etc
And now it goes by the shadowed way
O the wicked thing to do
O wretched little sparrow...poor little eyes

- Reminds her too much of what it did when it was alive:

But hopping round about...to mistress alone
