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## **Supplementary Notes for Markers**

- 1 Markers are asked to ensure that marks are entered in the correct columns. Column 1 is for KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING and column 2 is for ENQUIRY SKILLS. Marks should be recorded in the appropriate box.
- 2 It is strongly emphasised that the references in the marking instructions indicating expected responses are for guidance only and MUST NOT BE VIEWED AS PRESCRIPTIVE. The performance of candidates is measured against the Extended Grade Related Criteria and it is against these, rather than a checklist of responses, that they should be assessed.

#### **QUESTION 1**

(a) The concept being assessed is Representation. Candidates are required to recognise the concept in operation.

Award 1 mark for each correct answer.

The correct responses are: A and C

#### Knowledge and Understanding, 2 marks available

(b) Candidates are required to make comparisons within a source and draw valid conclusions.

Award 1 mark for each statement correctly identified.

Statements which are true:

- A In 2008, Scotland had the highest % of people in a Trade Union.
- **D** Between 1998 and 2008 no country had an increase in Trade Union membership.

Statements which are false:

- **B** In 1998, both England and Wales were below the UK average.
- C Northern Ireland had the second highest % in 1998.

#### **Enquiry Skills, 4 marks available**

(c) Candidates are required to state a heading for an investigation.

Award 1 mark for the correct heading.

The correct heading is: A Debates in the Scottish Parliament

#### **Enquiry Skills, 1 mark available**

(d) Candidates are required to justify a method of enquiry for an investigation.

Award 1 mark for the correct response.

The correct response is: **B** Many people find e-mail an easy way to keep in touch.

## Enquiry Skills, 1 mark available

(e) Candidates are required to identify two advantages of a method of enquiry.

Award 1 mark for each correct response.

The correct responses are: **B** and **C** 

# **Enquiry Skills, 2 marks available**

(f) Candidates are required to identify two advantages of a method of enquiry.

Award 1 mark for each way correctly identified.

The correct responses are:

- Way 1 Mary could click on the link 'what Jean does for her constituents'.
- Way 2 Mary could click on the link 'MSPs and their work in the Scottish Parliament'.
- Way 3 Mary could use the 'Quick Search' facility.
- Way 4 Mary could click on the link 'Political Activities'.

#### **SYLLABUS AREA 2 – CHANGING SOCIETY**

#### **QUESTION 2**

(a) The concept being assessed is Ideology. Candidates are required to recognise the concept in operation.

Award 1 mark for each correct response.

The correct responses are:

- A National Health Service
- D State Retirement Pension

#### Knowledge and Understanding, 2 marks available

(b) The concept being assessed is Equality. Candidates are required to provide brief explanations.

Award 1 mark for each word correctly placed.

The correct responses are:

Some elderly people have a private pension and **savings** in the bank.

This is because they had **well** paid jobs before retirement.

They are also in good health, and do not suffer from illnesses such as arthritis or dementia.

If they become ill, they will get treatment more quickly because they may have **private** health care.

Knowledge and Understanding, 4 marks available

(c) Candidates are required to provide evidence to support a given point of view.

Award up to 2 marks for a reason, depending on the quality of the explanation.

For example:

The following receives 1 mark:

Females aged 18-24 are the highest.

The following receives 2 marks:

• Females aged 18-24 have the highest % of people who do not work. The figure is 39%.

## **Enquiry Skills, 2 marks available**

(d) Candidates are required to identify differences between the two sources.

Award up to 2 marks for each difference correctly identified.

The correct responses are:

#### Difference 1

Source 1 says, "The group that falls most often on dangerous pavements is the elderly." But in Source 2 it says, "Disabled people are the group who suffer most falls on unsafe pavements."

#### Difference 2

Source 1 says "The best solution is to put adverts in local newspapers to warn people to take more care when out walking."

But in Source 2 it says, "Spending millions of pounds to repair dangerous pavements is the best way to get rid of the problem."

#### **SYLLABUS AREA 3 – IDEOLOGIES**

#### **QUESTION 3(A) - THE USA**

(a) The concept being assessed is Ideology. Candidates are required to recognise the concept in operation.

Award 1 mark for each correct response.

The correct responses are:

- **B** I own a successful business.
- **C** I can now afford to provide good health care for my family.

## Knowledge & Understanding, 2 marks available

(b) The concept being assessed is Participation. Candidates are required to provide a brief explanation.

Award 1 mark for each way correctly identified.

Award 1 mark for each explanation as to why they do it.

Answers may include:

Voting: People in America do this because they want to show their

views in an election.

Protesting: People in America do this to show they are unhappy about a

particular issue.

Standing as a candidate: People in America do this in order to change the way

something is done.

Any other valid point

(c) Candidates are required to make comparisons within a source and draw valid conclusions.

Award 1 mark for each statement that is correctly identified as being true.

The correct responses are: A and D

## Enquiry Skills, 2 marks available

(d) Candidates are required to support a given point of view.

Award up to 2 marks for the reason, depending on the extent of the exemplification.

Answers may include:

#### I agree with Ross Henderson because:

The Public Opinion Poll shows that 33% think President Obama is doing a very good job, 23% think he is doing a good job and 4% are satisfied with the job he is doing. This shows that over half of the people surveyed in the poll (60%) are therefore pleased with the job he is doing.

## **Enquiry Skills, 2 marks available**

(e) Candidates are required to detect exaggeration.

Award 1 mark for each statement that is correctly identified as being exaggerated.

The correct responses are:

- **B** Hispanics made greater use of the Internet than Blacks.
- **D** Whites made less use of the Internet than Hispanics.

#### **QUESTION 3(B) – CHINA**

(a) The concept being assessed is Ideology. Candidates are required to recognise the concept in operation.

Award 1 mark for each correct response.

The correct responses are:

- B I earn high wages.
- **C** I am getting a good education.

#### Knowledge & Understanding, 2 marks available

(b) The concept being assessed is Participation. Candidates are required to provide a brief explanation.

Award 1 mark for each way correctly identified.

Award 1 mark for each explanation as to why they do it.

Answers may include:

Voting: People in China do this because they want to show their views

in an election.

Protesting: People in China do this to show they are unhappy about a

particular issue.

• Standing as a candidate: People in China do this in order to change the way something

is done.

Any other valid point

The correct responses are: A and D

The Public Opinion Poll shows that 33% think President Hu Jintao is doing a very good job, 23% think he is doing a good job and 29% are satisfied with the job he is doing. This shows that over half of the people surveyed in the poll (85%) are therefore pleased with the job he is doing.

The correct responses are:

- **B** Government workers made more use of the Internet than the self-employed.
- **D** Rural workers made more use of the Internet than the self-employed.

#### **SYLLABUS AREA 4 – INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS**

#### **QUESTION 4**

(a) The concept being assessed is Power. Candidates are required to recognise the concept in operation.

Award 1 mark for each correct response.

The correct responses are: B and C

## Knowledge and Understanding, 2 marks available

(b) The concept being assessed is Need. Candidates are required to provide brief explanations.

Award 1 mark for each word correctly placed.

The correct responses are:

NATO aircraft provide early warning of attacks.

NATO troops have helped to run the **election** in Afghanistan.

NATO orders for weapons keep thousands of people in jobs.

NATO forces have tried to stop **pirates** attacking ships.

Knowledge and Understanding, 4 marks available

(c) The candidates are required to detect examples of exaggeration.

Award 1 mark for each correct response.

The correct responses are: A and C

## **Enquiry Skills, 2 marks available**

(d) Candidates are required to provide evidence to both support and oppose a given point of view.

The correct responses are:

Evidence to support the view: A and B

Evidence to oppose the view: C and D
