The Eskimos

The Eskimos live in the far north of Canada and Greenland. The land is covered with snow and ice nearly all the year round. They are small people with pale faces, slanting eyes and straight black hair. They don't cut their hair because they think it is unlucky. They wear furry hooded anoraks, which have no buttons but slip over the head. Waterproof trousers and gloves keep their hands warm and dry. They often wear two pairs of sealskin boots to keep out the cold. The Eskimo looks fatter than he really is because of his thick clothes.

When they go out on long hunting trips in winter, they build beehive-shaped huts called igloos. The Eskimo may take less than an hour to build an igloo.

10 When not out on hunting, Eskimos live in modern wooden houses. Most villages have electricity, a school shop and airfield.

The Eskimos are clever hunters and fishermen. They travel over the snow and ice on sledges drawn by a team of dogs called Huskies. The Eskimos hunt with a rifle although years ago they used spears known as harpoons.
