2. Microfibres are very fine fibres, usually less than one denier thick. They can be sengineered to produce specific qualities and functions. Manufacturers generally produce a fibre as possible to make the fabrics light in weight, strong, crease resistant, soft and sheer to handle and with excellent draping qualities. The surface of the woven fabric is coated with polyurethane which repels water. Water can still evaporate through tiny pores however water cannot get through, so the body is left dry even after exercise. Microfibres are usually made from polyester or polyamide.
