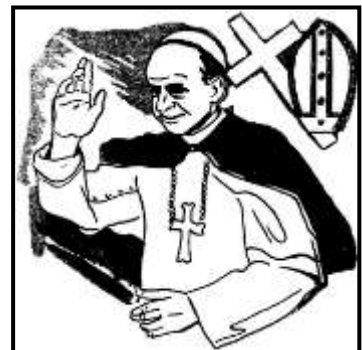

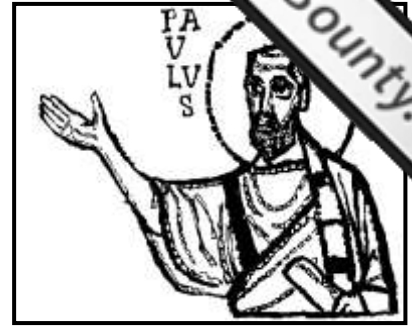

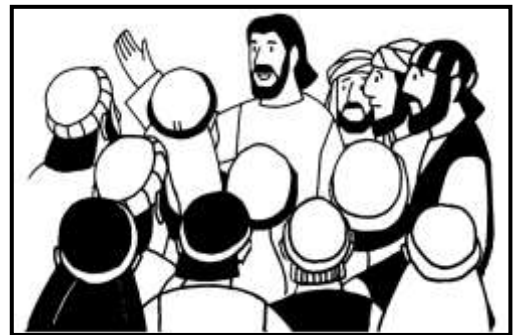
Read this excerpt and then answer the following questions.
