Instructions for the conduct of the Listening Comprehension Examination

The teacher should instruct the candidates to answer the questions on the paper provided. The following procedure for reading the Listening Comprehension passage is to be explained to the candidates immediately before proceeding with the examination.

You have been given a sheet containing the Listening Comprehension questions. You will be given three minutes to read the questions based on the passage. I shall then read the passage at normal reading speed. You may take notes during the reading. After this reading there will be a pause of another three minutes to enable you to answer some of the questions. The passage will be read a second time and you may take further notes and answer the rest of the questions. After this second reading you will be given a further three minutes for a final revision of answers.

- a. 3 minutes - Read questions
- b. 3 minutes - First reading aloud of passage while students take notes
- c. 3 minutes - Answer questions
- d. 3 minutes - Second reading of passage and possibility to answer questions
- e. 3 minutes - Final revision

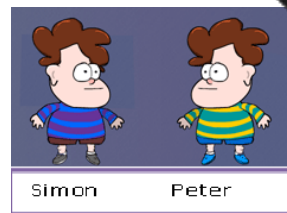

Teenager injured at work

18-year-old John Falzon, from Floriana, works with Peterson Paint Ltd. Yesterday morning he broke his left leg. He also suffered many cuts and bruises when a number of heavy metal tins full of paint fell on him.

Mr Falzon is employed as a cleaner in the Marsa factory. Another factory employee, Mark Sammut, was pushing a trolley loaded with tins full of paint. The trolley overturned and the tins fell on Mr Falzon.

The victim was rushed to hospital and operated on immediately. John Falzon is not in danger of dying, but he will have to stay in hospital for ten days. He will not be able to return to work for two months.

The Health and Safety Officer reported that the accident happened because the factory floor was old and in a bad state. Mark Sammut was a new employee and he had never used a trolley before.

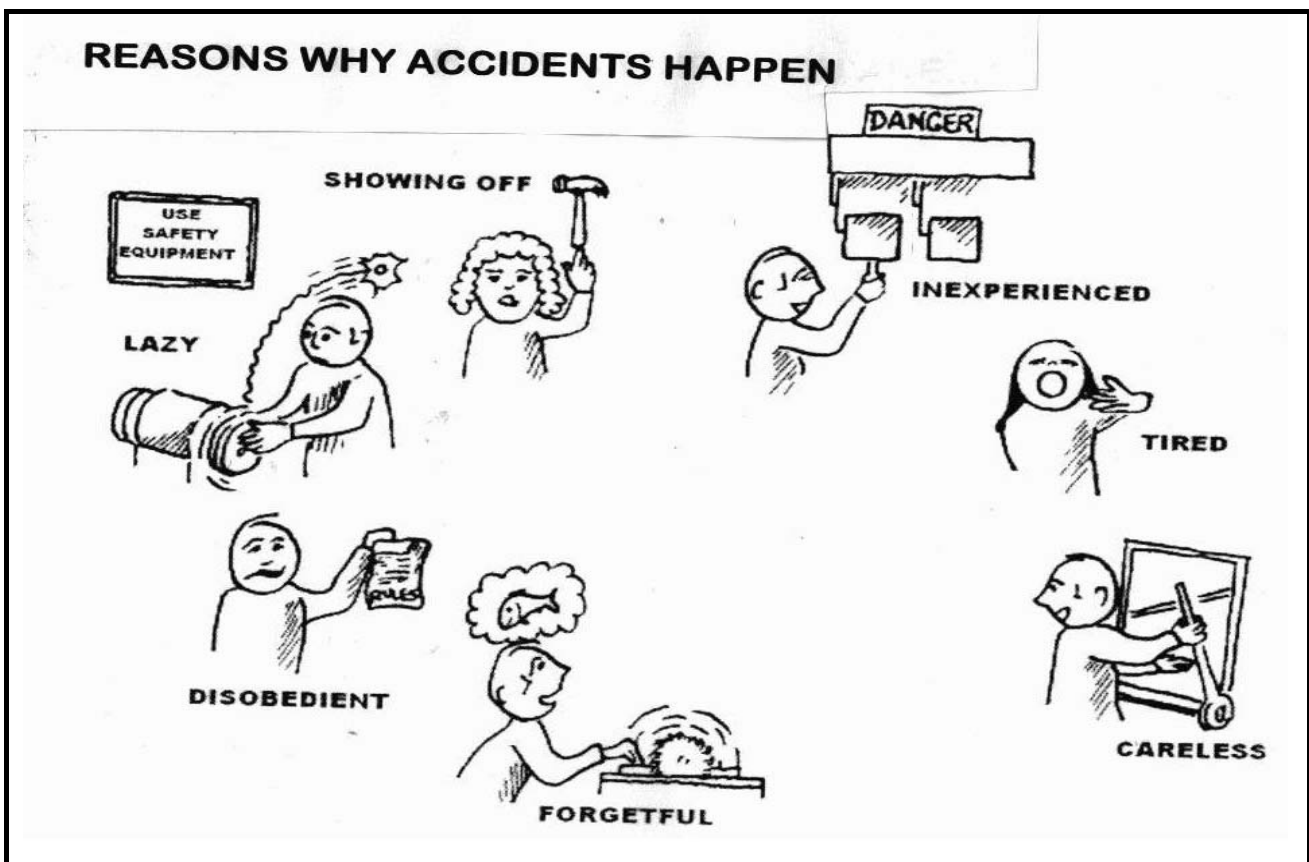

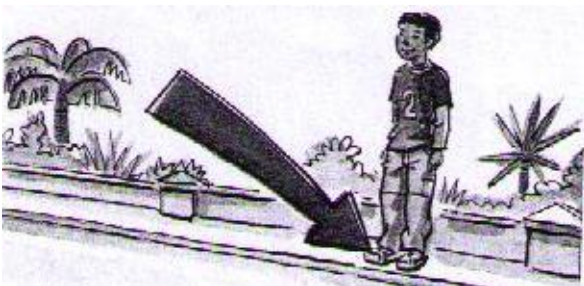

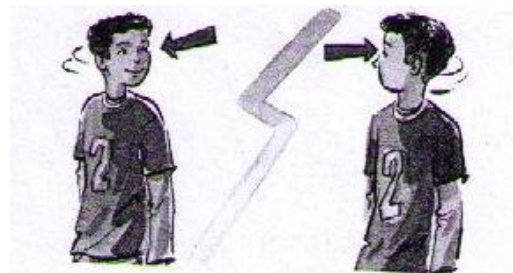
