
Read the passage carefully. Answer the questions that follow in complete sentences. (10marks)

Their skin and fur were used to make clother. When food became hard to find, the Stone Age people moved to a new cave near more plants and animals.

Stone Age people fived and hunted together in a group called a tribe. The leader or chief was one of the hunters. He would lead the rest in hunting for wild animals.

During the Stone Age tools were made using flint. Flint could be broken into pieces when it was hit against a rock. These pieces were year sharp. They were used as knives and spearheads.


